

# 1. Opening

## 1.3 Follow up from previous DRESG meeting

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- To contribute to **monitoring progress** in the DR NC implementation process, as well as the **operation and functioning of the processes and arrangements** established according to the DR NC – at local, regional and pan-European level – and in **general topics related to demand response**;



- To serve as a **platform to share general views** on the DR NC implementation, with a particular focus to enable stakeholders to **express their views and receive feedback**;








- To contribute to a more **informed decision-making process** for the **methodologies and rules** to be developed for the implementation of the DR NC.



- DRESG is **not** the same as the **drafting committee**.
- It **builds** upon the **close cooperation**, **open exchanges**, **common understanding** and **cohesion** that was developed during the phase of the drafting of the DR NC, both
  - when **EU DSO Entity and ENTSO-E** were **drafting** their DR NC proposal, in the context of the **formal role** that the drafting committee had, but also afterwards,
  - during the **ACER revision process**, when ACER chose to keep the interaction with the drafting committee, even without the formal role.
- The **scope** and the **kind of the interactions** are now **different**; the scope is broader and we are not working on drafting a text.
- However, we continue working with the **same goal**, which is to **enable demand response participation in wholesale electricity markets**, and we continue sharing the **same values**: trust through openness, mutual respect, clear communication.

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- In the following slides we summarise the **main points raised**, which we are committed to address (including actions already taken).
  - It is an on-going process: **whenever** you have **comments/suggestions** either on **process** or **content**, please **raise** them either during the meeting or by sending an email to the organisers/chair.

- Organisers to **share the agenda** well in advance to trigger reactions from stakeholders.  
=> 1<sup>st</sup> draft agenda was shared on 23 March (4 weeks in advance); final agenda (including proposed interventions from stakeholders) was shared 9 April (2 weeks in advance). 
- Whenever feedback is asked, **sufficient time** should be provided for representatives to consult with their members **to provide input**. 
- Use DRESG to **share experience** with implementation projects and **increase common knowledge**, by diving into specific topics, having dedicated workshops, etc. (any **ideas** on that are welcome). 
- **Clarify processes (and deliverables)** and working structures whenever this is needed. 
- It is important to ensure that **all associations are involved and being heard**, also the smaller ones. 

## Baselining methods (more in-depth discussions)

- MSs seems to follow a more **flexible approach**; as new type of devices and EV are connected, the **methodologies need to adapt** to new assets => more flexible decision making.

## Standardisation of data exchange (harmonisation)

- focusing on how to avoid **different models for data exchange** for the **same products** across Europe;
- **data access** to DSO meters tackled from a regulatory perspective;
- need to bring **balancing and local services** discussion **together**.

## DMDs (harmonisation in use)

- how DMDs are used to **collect data** in different **cases**;
- currently we could have national implementation where DMDs are not permitted.

- The **topics** and the **level of depth** of the relevant discussions will also depend on the **final text of the DR NC**.
- As part of its **monitoring exercise** (focus monitoring reports), ACER intends to cover (some of) the topics raised.
- **Coordination** between **balancing** and **local services** is needed and ensured through discussion of relevant topics.
