## Update on 70% derogation approval processes

- Reminder: overview of derogations and action plans for 2020, 2021 and 2022 listed on ACER's web page: Ø link
- Since the summer, TSOs have reached out to their NRAs for follow-up derogations from the 70% requirement, for the period 1 Jan. 2023 31 Dec. 2023 (most derogations only apply for 1 year, in application of the Regulation's provisions)
- The following table provides a preliminary overview of the derogations requests for 2023 which were circulated among NRAs (note: Regulation prescribes a validation process by all <u>affected</u> NRAs, hence the circulation)

(rows ordered by date of notification from the respective NRA in the validation process)

- Based on the available information, most national approval processes are currently ongoing.
- Additional derogation requests may still be submitted in the coming weeks.
- Processes and criteria for grating derogations have been, to a large extent, harmonized across jurisdictions thanks to the extensive efforts of ACER and the involved NRAs (cf. discussions at March '22 MESC meeting)
