Capacity analysis / 70% monitoring

Opinion ‘on the necessary developments for the fulfilment of the minimum cross-zonal capacity requirements’

- To be published in March 2024
- Based on ACER’s 2023 monitoring:
 - Market monitoring report on Cross-zonal capacities and the 70% margin available for cross-zonal electricity trade (MACZT)
 - Market monitoring report on the progress of EU wholesale market integration
- In line with ACER’s monitoring strategy¹
- Input from public consultation during summer 2023
- Goal
 - Raise awareness on the detected difficulties in the implementation of the requirement
 - Stress the need to implement the necessary methodologies promptly
 - Prepare stakeholders on the importance of upcoming decisions in established processes

- ENTSO-E and ACER have been coordinating on the 70% monitoring topic
 - Dedicated meetings ongoing
- ACER's 2024 monitoring will have
 - Context of the 70% monitoring and the ACER mandate
 - Data streams will be aligned in 2024
 - Clear communication on what is monitoring of transitional requirements and what is monitoring against 70% requirement

ACER electricity market monitoring reports

‘Key developments in EU electricity wholesale markets’

- To start the publication cycle of ACER market monitoring reports
- To be published mid-March 2024
 - Traditional key market indicators on the evolution of load, demand, generation, prices
 - Section dedicated to similar indicators for the Energy Community
