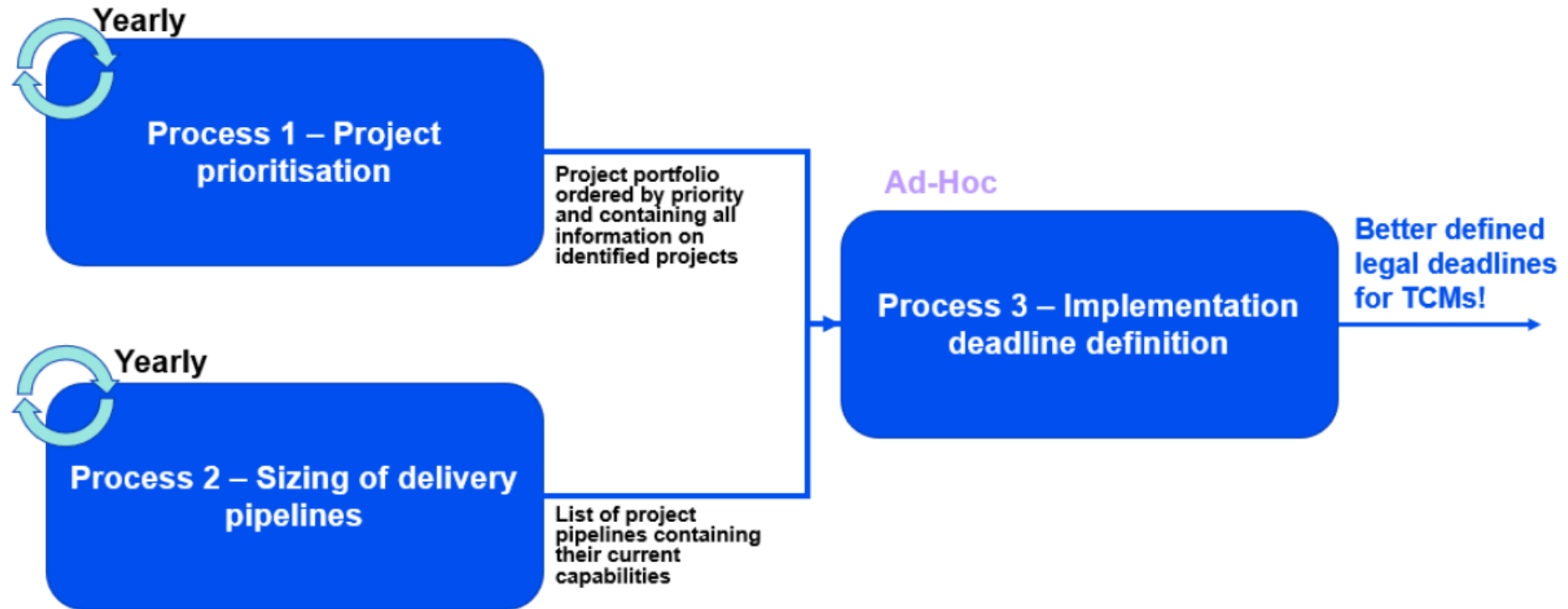
Project prioritisation 2024: Kick-off meeting

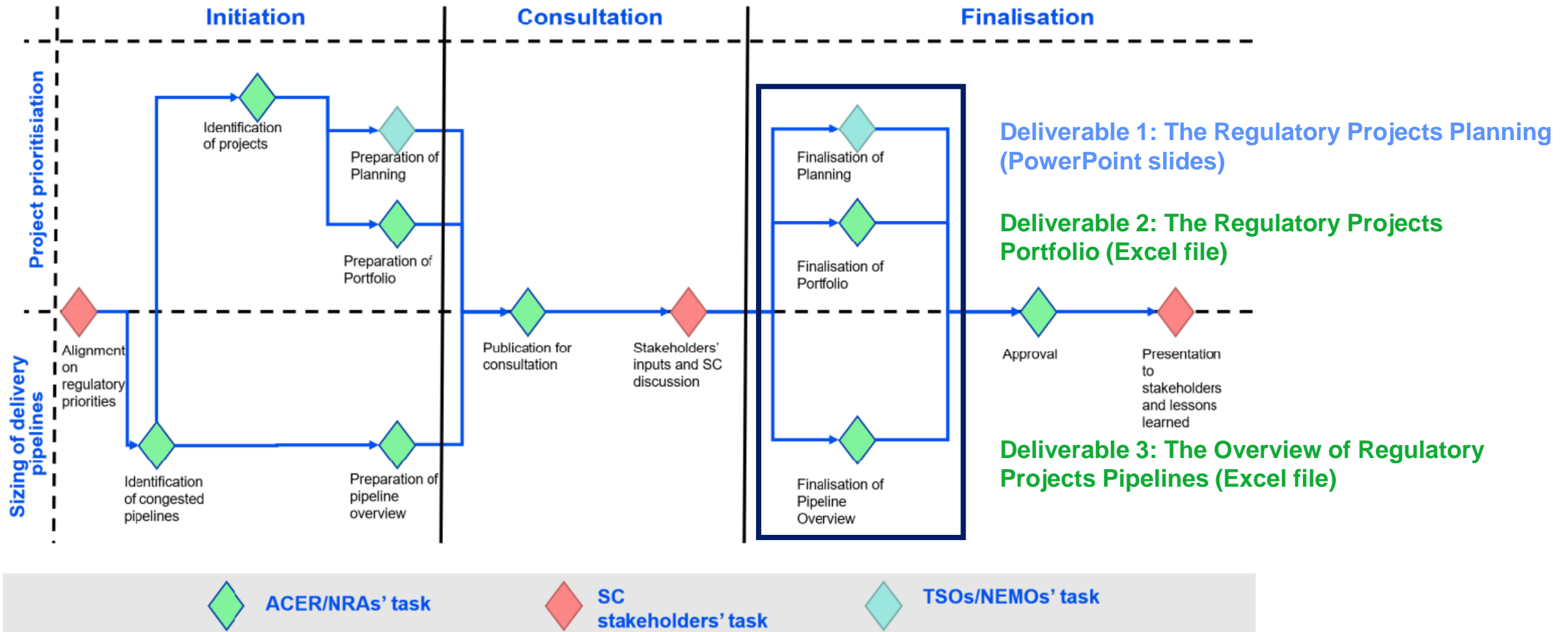


Background: Objectives of the prioritisation exercise

- Throughout 2023, a project prioritisation process was defined, in cooperation with TSOs, NEMOs and MPs. **The guidance was endorsed by the MESC on 18 October 2023.**
- The objectives for the introduction of this guidance are:
 1. **Improve the way regulatory projects are planned** (i.e. their regulatory deadline is defined) to better consider the ongoing implementations and current implementation capabilities.
 2. Allow for a **better and more transparent long-term planning of regulatory projects**, considering a few key criteria.
 3. **Involve stakeholders** in the identification of implementation priorities.
- The objectives for the introduction of this guidance are not to:
 1. **Revise the existing legal or regulatory deadlines** and challenge ongoing implementations.
 2. **Consider new projects** or adding to the pipeline projects **which are not mandated** or necessary to implement the ones mandated by regulatory or legal texts.



Steps, division of tasks and deliverables

Projects with an implementation date
between S2 2025 and 2028



19 January: Kick-off meeting with MESC members



Mid-February: Meeting with NEMOs and TSOs



28 February: Discussion at MESC



4 March – 29 March: Targeted consultation with MESC members



April: Meetings with NEMOs and TSOs and MESC members



13 June: Presentation of the final deliverables at MESC
