

TERRE Project TSOs Announce Decision on 48 or 96 Gates Implementation

Following a comprehensive review of the public survey results from 2023, and in light of recent developments in EU energy legislation, the Transmission System Operators (TSOs) of the TERRE project have reached a significant decision.

After careful evaluation of the impacts, it has been concluded that the implementation of 48 or 96 gates in the TERRE project will not proceed. RR process will remain with 24 gates. This decision is based on a thorough understanding of the current energy landscape, the new legal framework and the potential implications of such implementation.

As a direct consequence of this decision, Replacement Reserves (RR) TSOs will disconnect from the platform in the coordinated manner, the operation of the RR platform will come to an end when last TSOs disconnect, at this time expected at end 2025.

The TERRE project TSOs remain committed to ensuring the stability and efficiency of the energy market and will continue to make decisions that reflect this commitment.
