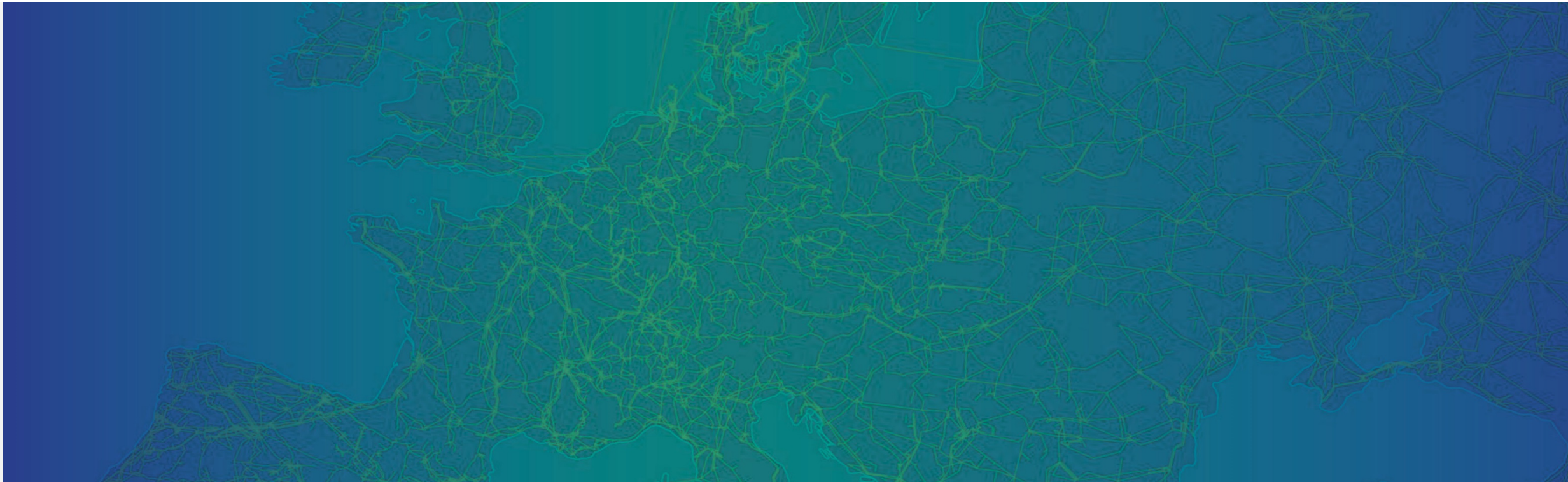

# What are project sheets?

## What are project sheets and why are they important?

A project's sheet centralises all information on the project and on its assessment in the TYNDP2020.

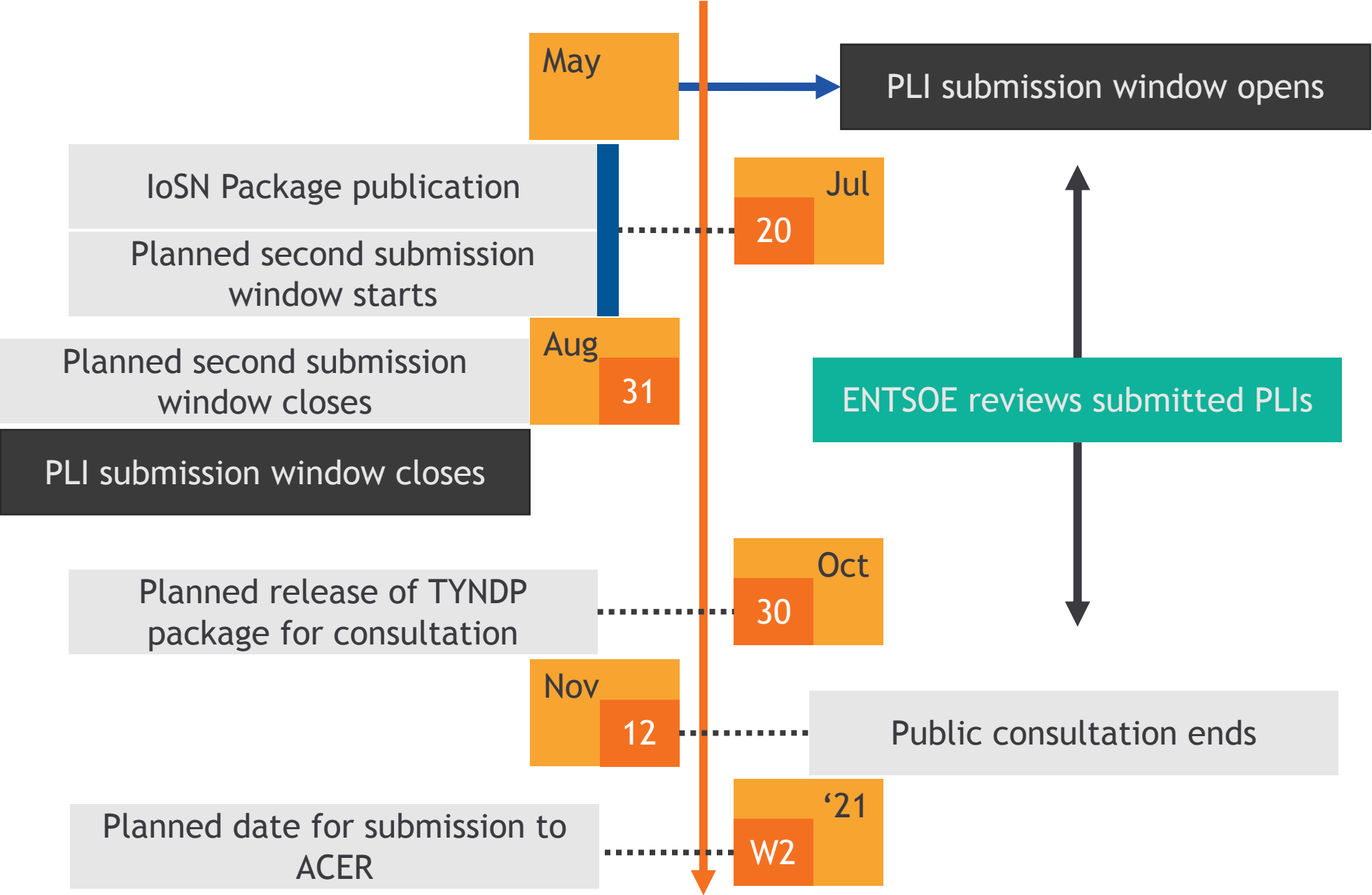
Projects sheets will be used by the European Commission and PCI Regional Groups in the 5<sup>th</sup> PCI process

Project sheets will be publicly available as online webpages, downloadable as PDF. When a project's name is entered in Google, the project sheets of past TYNDPs generally appear among the first few results.

Time window to complete the projects sheets: from **May to 30 June 2020**

# Current state of the project sheet functionalities

## ABOUT THE DRAFT PROJECT SHEETS SHARED WITH PROMOTERS IN MAY 2020

The projects sheets of the TYNDP2020 are still in draft form. Please note that the following improvements are ongoing and will be deployed in the few coming weeks:

- Functionality to download the projects sheet in PDF;
- Functionality to download the CBA results in excel (once the CBA results become available);
- Addition of 'Projects Sheet Explainers' – they will contain a brief explanation on each component of the sheets and links to relevant documents where necessary. The few Project Sheet Explainers currently included in the project sheets are not final and many more will be added;
- Improved responsiveness of the sheets (accessibility on mobile devices);
- Functionality for promoters to upload pictures.



# Previewing project sheets

Log into the TYNDP 2020 platform at: <https://tyndp2020-project-platform.azurewebsites.net/>

Promoters can preview the project sheets by clicking on the 'Preview' button, on the right-hand side of each project in the projects list.



# Information to be completed in the project sheets

Information still required from promoters at this stage belongs to one of three categories:

- Information required as per the draft CBA Guideline for the assessment of the project (e.g. residual environmental impact). Providing this information is mandatory.
- Submission of project-level benefits (optional).
- Information required only for communication purposes, e.g. audiovisual material. Providing this information is optional but recommended.

# Mandatory information

- Residual impact (mandatory if your project has a residual impact)

Residual social impact

Residual environmental impact

Other residual impact

- B8 System Stability (for transmission projects)

- Life-cycle CAPEX

# Additional information on the project (recommended, not mandatory)

Why does ENTSO-E ask for additional information?

For consistency with ACER monitoring:

- field 'Type of element', to complete for each investment
- Field type of project (is it new infrastructure or an upgrade of existing infrastructure)

For communication purposes:

- Link to a video
- edit the project description
- update the field 'Additional information on the project'
- Information on related projects
- Possibility to provide updated technical data (if needed)
- Upload the promoter's logo
