





## **TYNDP 2022 Project Sheets**


### What are Project Sheets?

- Project Sheets present the results of the cost-benefit analysis, key information and context behind each project assessed in the TYNDP 2022.
- Project Sheets are used by the European Commission and PCI Regional Groups in the PCI processes.
- Project sheets will be publicly available as online webpages, downloadable as PDF and Excel Spreadsheets.
- When a project's name is entered in Google, the project sheets of past TYNDPs projects generally appear among the first few results.

#### Welcome to the TYNDP 2022 Projects Platform

Welcome to the TYNDP 2022 platform. The application window to TYNDP 2022 will open on 15 September and close on 15 October 2021, at 12.00 (midday) Brussels time.

Before creating a new project or editing an existing project, promoters should read the **TYNDP 2022 Guidance**, which sets the requirements for valid submissions to TYNDP 2022.

## TYNDP 2022 project-level indicators (PLIs)

#### **Reference documents:**

Draft 3rd CBA Guideline

Implementation Guideline (will be published in the 1st week of March)

The 3rd CBA Guideline introduces the concept of **Project level indicators (PLIs)** based on promoters' input (Guideline chapter 3.4 and 6.26).

PLIs represent benefits or costs of a project (transmission or storage), which have been identified as important for a complete CBA, but that ENTSO-E is not able to assess at a Pan- European level within the TYNDP process.

The 3rd CBA guideline, as a consequence, includes the possibility for Project promoters to submit PLIs within the TYNDP process.

For PLIs, the 3rd CBA guideline provides a definition, a clear perimeter of application and a methodology that must be followed in order to properly assess them. Although the Pan-European nature of these indicators is recognized, it is acceptable to assess them relying on a regional or even national perimeter to deal with their inherent complexity.

### **PLIs' Next Steps**

1<sup>st</sup> week of March: release of the TYNDP 2022 implementation Guideline, detailing the available PLIs in TYNDP 2022 and the rules and modalities to submit them

**April**: Webinar for promoters on PLIs

**30 June**: deadline to submit PLIs

**July – August**: ENTSO-E reviews the submitted PLIs and verify their compliance with the Implementation Guideline

**August – Mid September**: ENTSO-E may contact promoters to request clarifications, confirm or correct the submitted PLIs

**September**: ENTSO-E notifies its decision regarding the compliance of PLIs to promoters

NB: Only information submitted by promoters in the English language can be considered



## **Review of CBA results by promoters**

- Based on the Guidance for Applicants, ENTSO-E has to share CBA results with promoters at least
  2 weeks before they are published
- Promoters may use these 2 weeks to review the results and to provide comments that will be inserted in the Project Sheets


### TIMELINE (TBC):

July: most CBA results for the 2030 horizon shared with project promoters for review

**Sep/Oct**: remaining CBA results shared with project promoters for review




